Fueling Kids' Futures Overview

- Fueling Kids' Futures is a "neighbor-helping-neighbor" program that is designed to help meet the nutritional needs of children and families.
- Each week, volunteers distribute bags filled with enough non-perishable food for the weekend (six meals) to hunger insecure students.
- Each bag contains food such as chicken, tuna, peanut butter, macaroni and cheese, soup, pastas, oatmeal, cereal, granola bars, and fruit juices.
- While it seems unlikely that children in an affluent community of Wyandotte would go to bed hungry on weekends, in reality, 58% of the students in the school districts participate in the Free or Reduced Fee Lunch program. Wyandotte has 2,343 children who qualify for the Fueling Kids' Futures program.
- The goal of the Fueling Kids' Futures program is to keep these students from going hungry on the weekends and remove barriers to academic success.
- The Wyandotte program provides for 410 children at the 4 elementary schools, the middle school, and the high school at a cost of \$65,600 annually. Please help us raise the money to reach this goal for the 2025-2026 school year.

Benefits of the Program

- Research shows that healthy, well-nourished children learn better, are more likely to attend school and are able to take advantage of educational opportunities.
- This program is making a difference in the lives of children. Results we have seen are:

Increase Test Scores	45-54%
Improved Attendance	23-48%
Decrease Behavioral Issues	25-35%
Greater Attention Spans	35-44%
Improved Class Atmosphere	47-60%
Chance for long term gains	Yes

Wyandotte Shores measures 3240 yards from the longest tees and has a slope rating of 113 and a 35.2 USGA rating. The course features 4 sets of tees for different skill levels. The course offers a Pro Shop and extensive concession stand. The course is municipally owned and operated.
